Dear Mr. Mitby:

Please be advised that the Harris County District Attorney's Office has completed its investigation into criminal allegations made against Alec Dreyer. Specifically, we investigated allegations that Mr. Dreyer misused the Marine Vessel Sam Houston and that he altered a governmental record in an effort to hide that misuse.

The Texas Water Code allows the Port of Houston to spend funds for promotion and development activities. Our investigation revealed that the April 27, 2009 special tour in question included a promotional presentation about the Port of Houston, and was requested and approved pursuant to normal guidelines in place at the Port.

Our investigation into an allegation that Mr. Dreyer improperly altered a governmental record relating to the use of the Marine Vessel Sam Houston revealed no criminal conduct. We found that the spread sheets alleged to be improperly altered were internal documents used by Mr. Dreyer to monitor the use of the vessel. The various changes merely reflected corrections, updates and differing formats.
